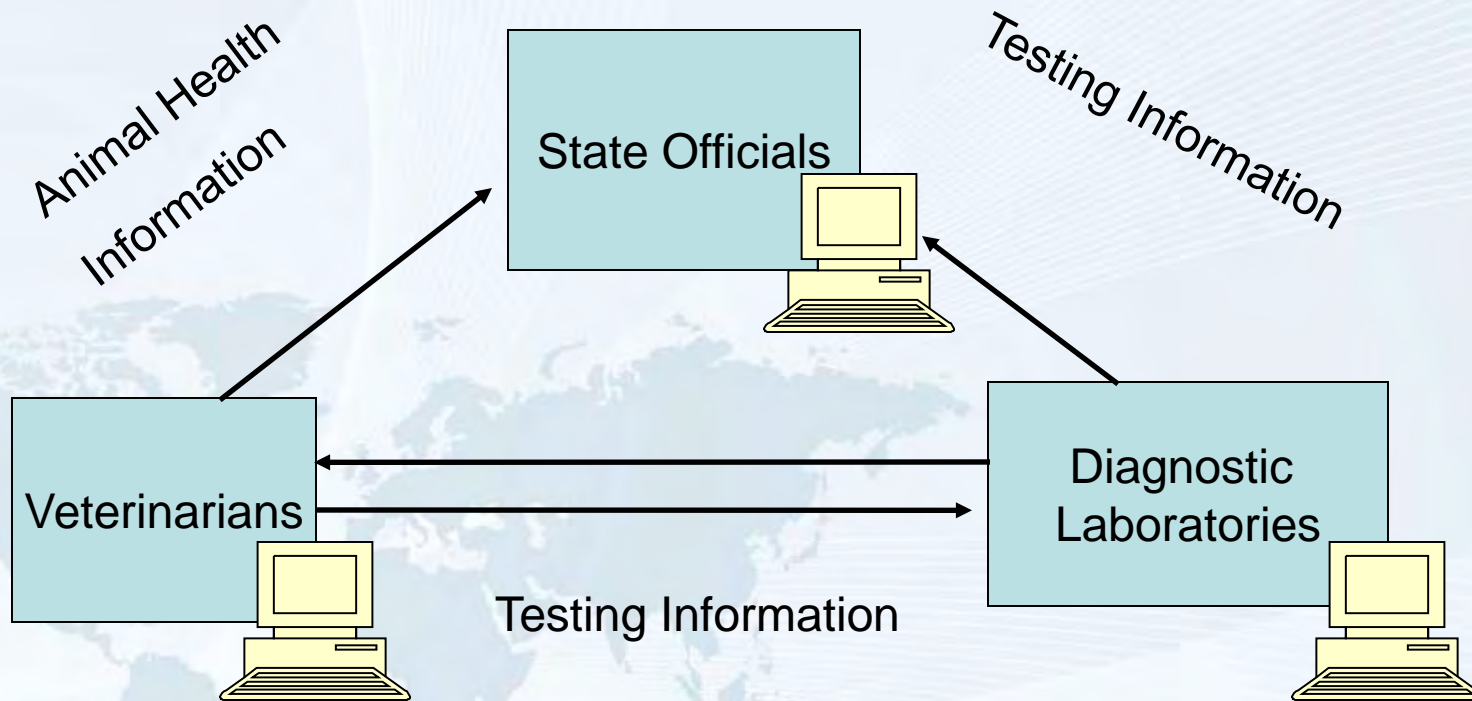
GlobalVetLink History - in Brief

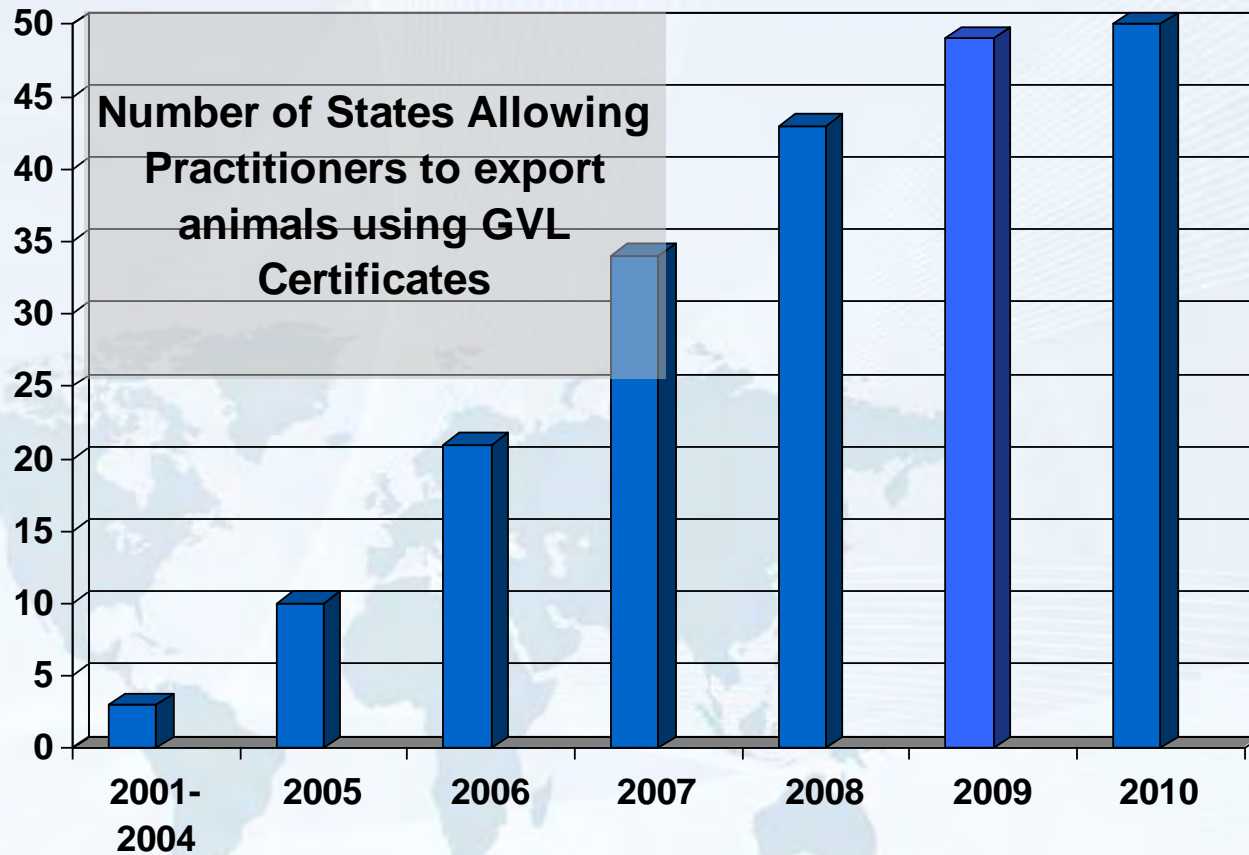


