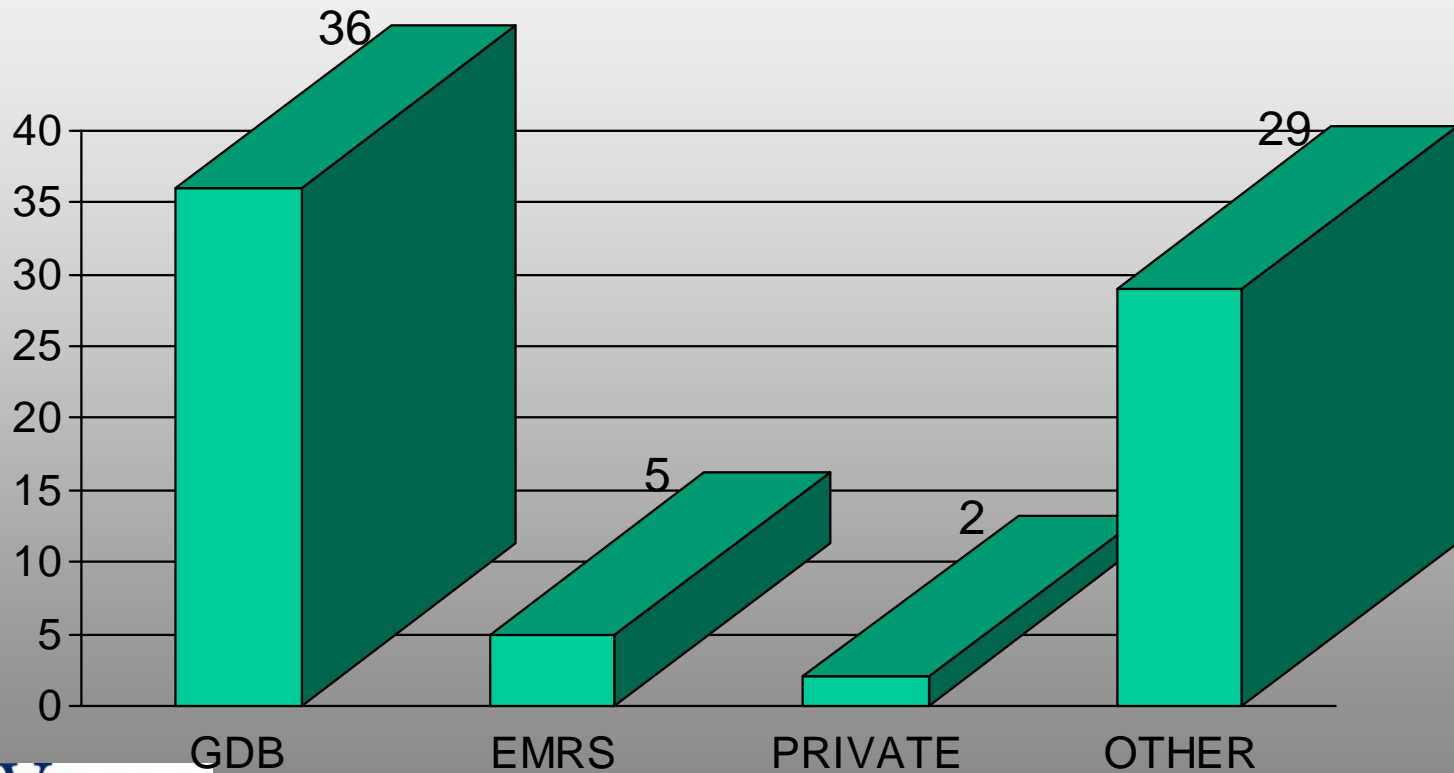

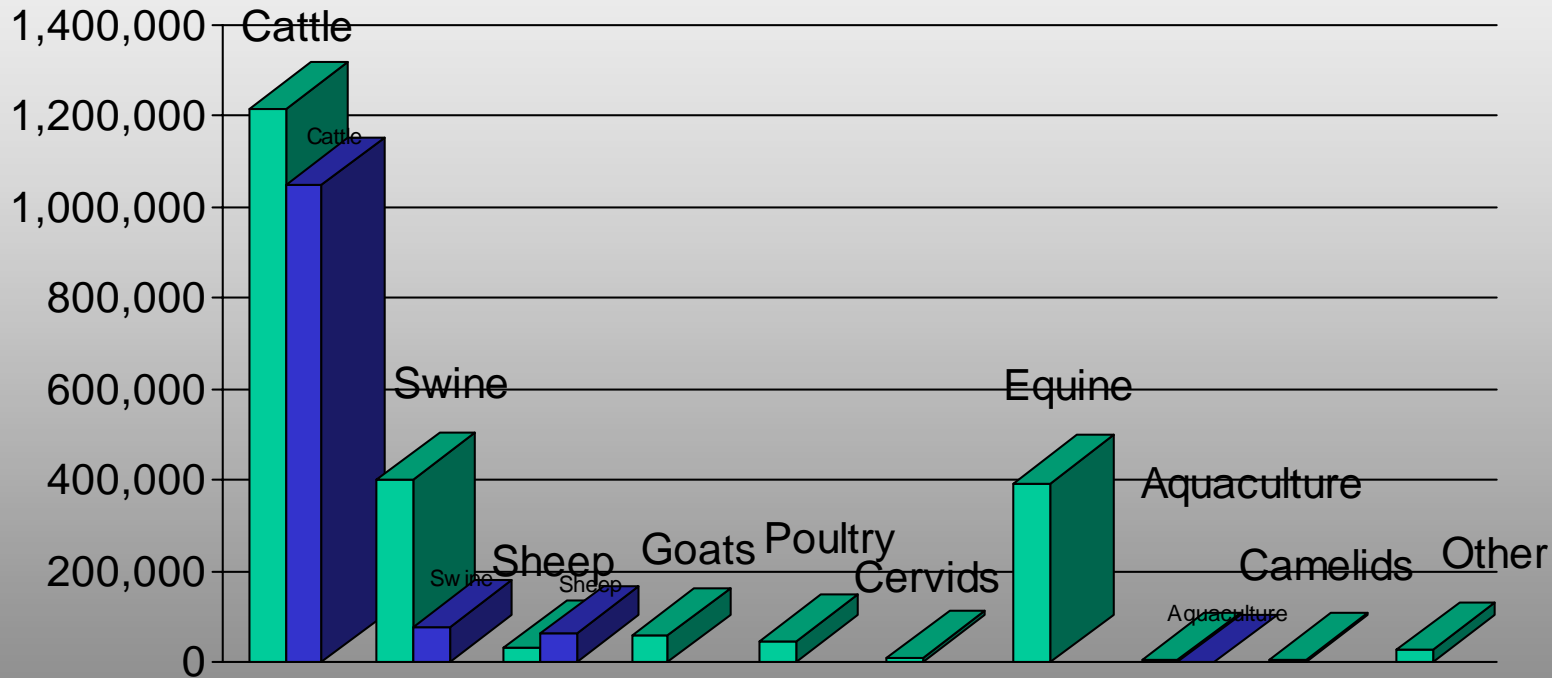

Number of Livestock Premises

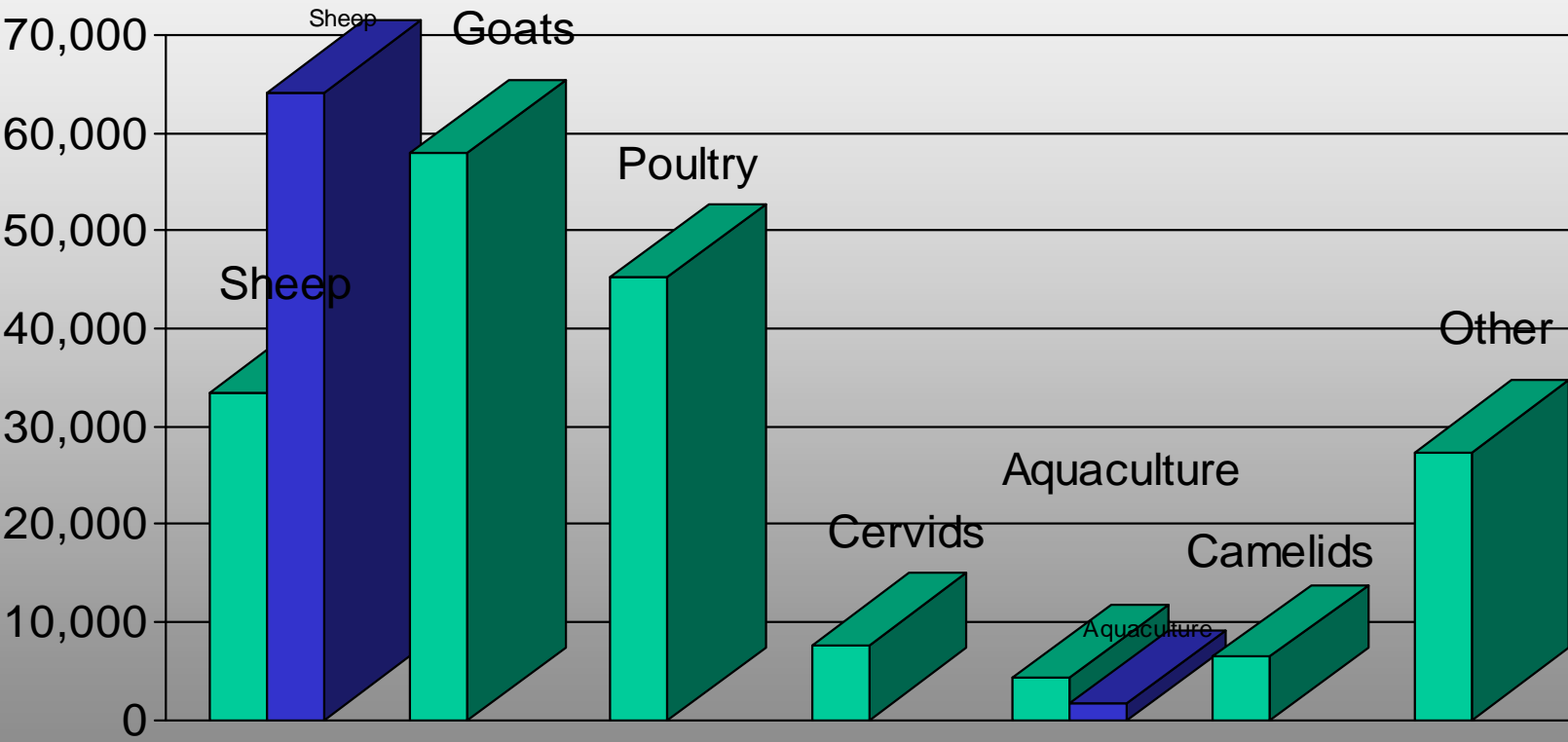


Total Premises on record = 1,792,367



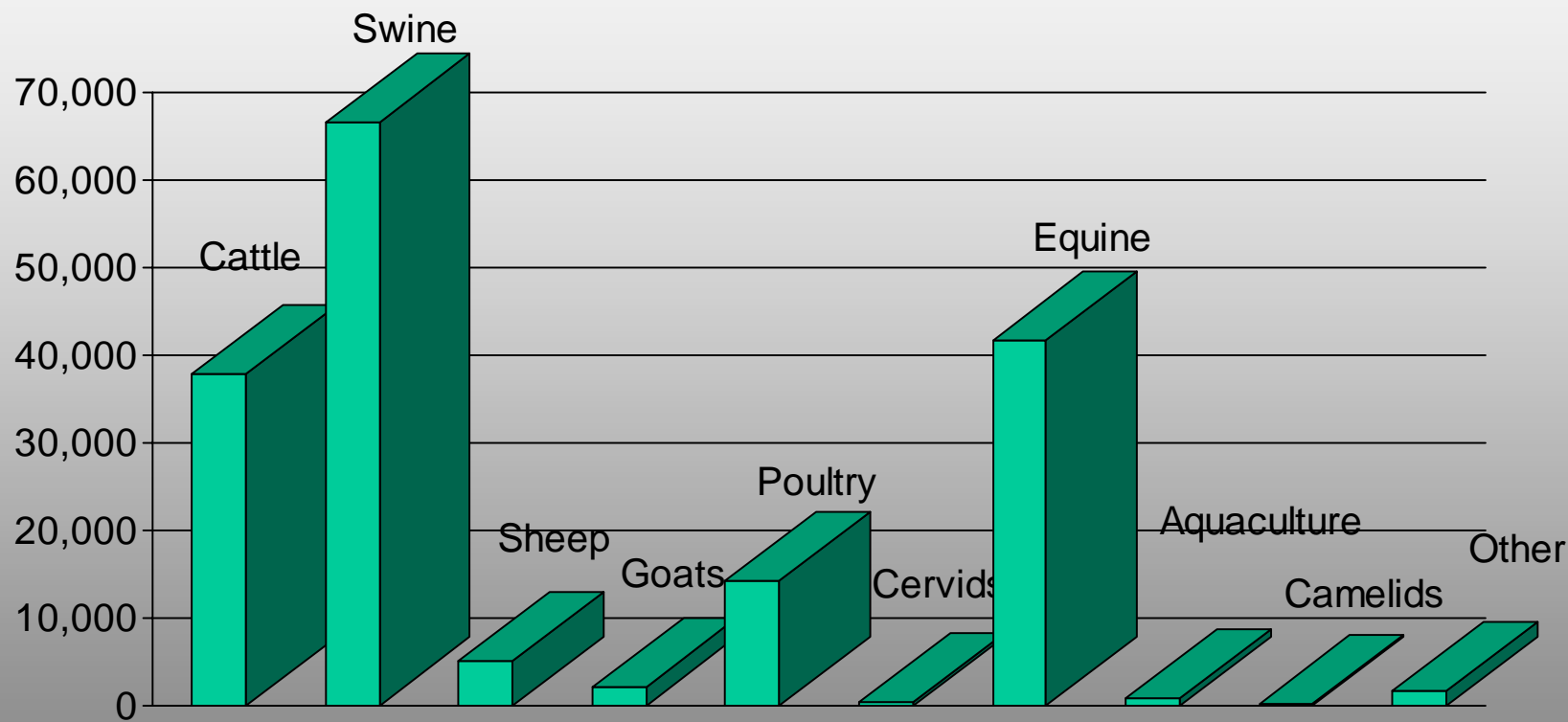

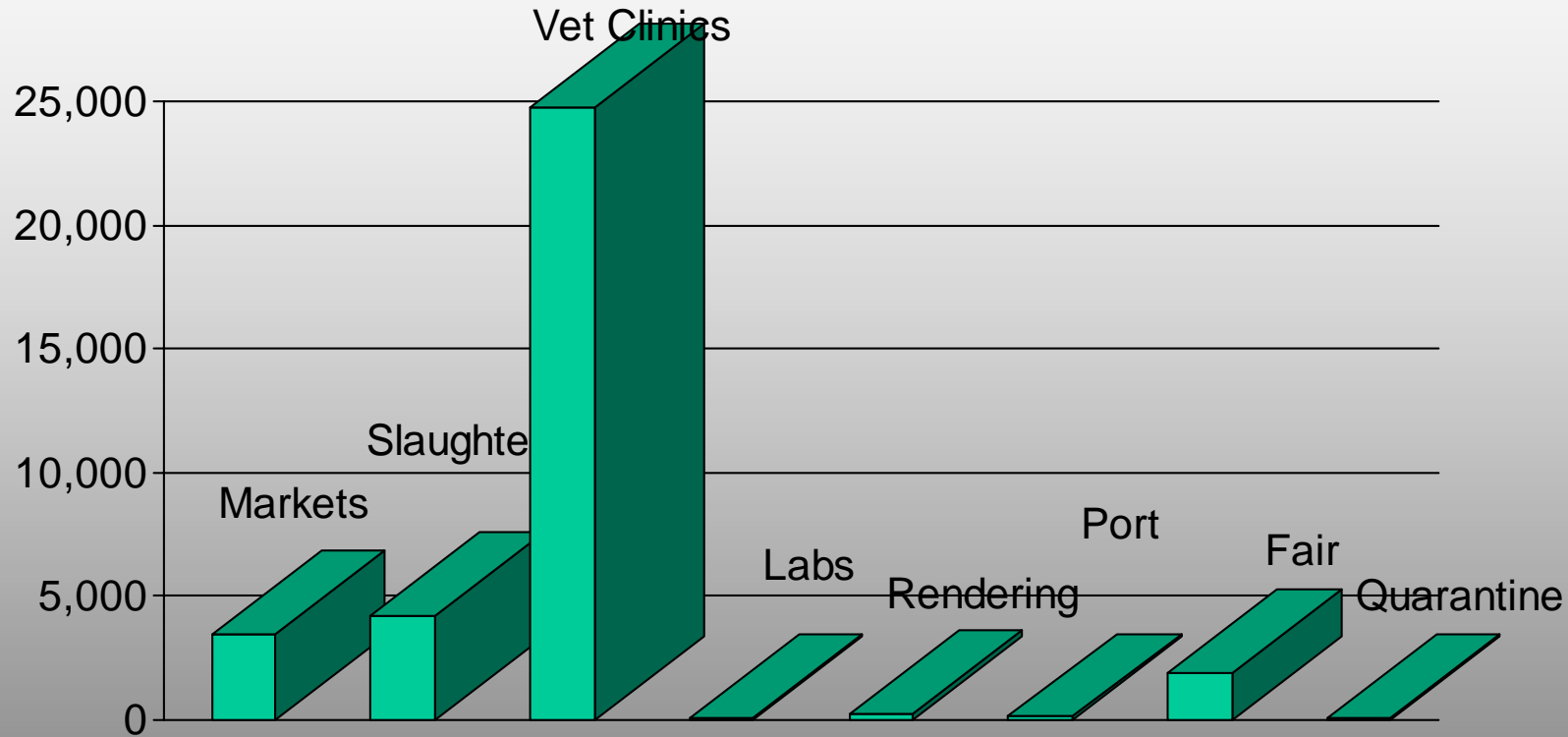
Livestock Premises with GIS Coordinates

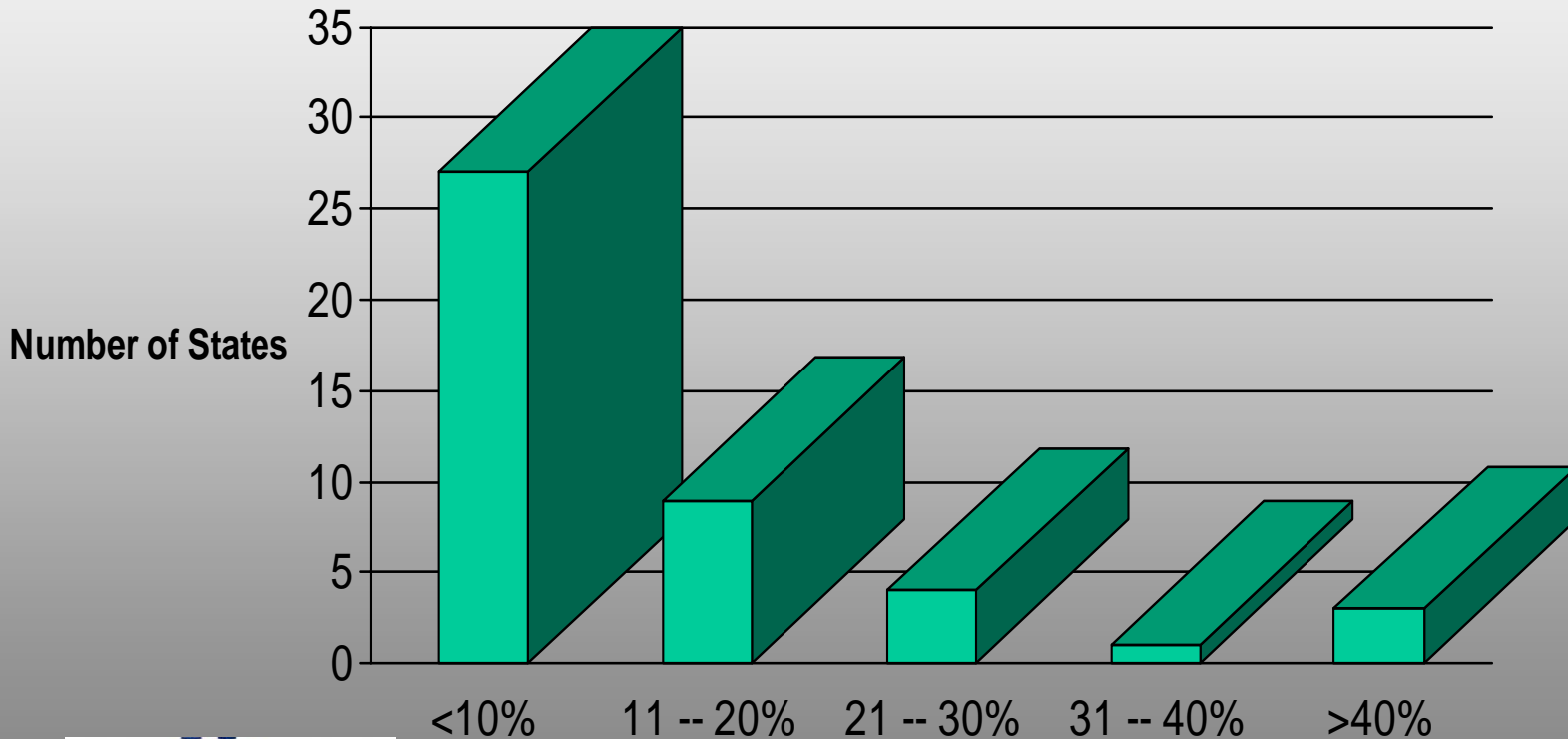
Other Premises



Total Premises on record = 34,767

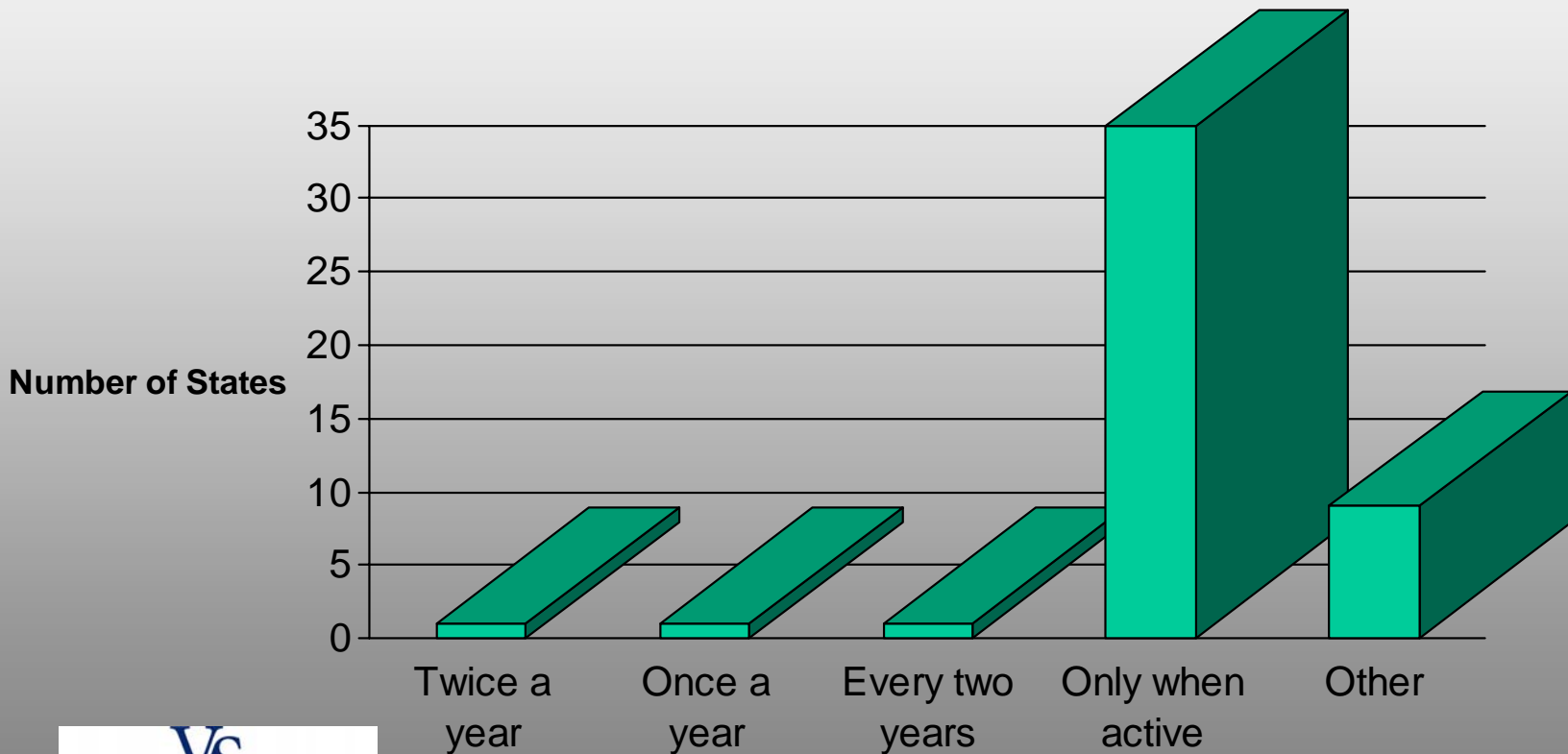

Percent of premises having more than one identification number



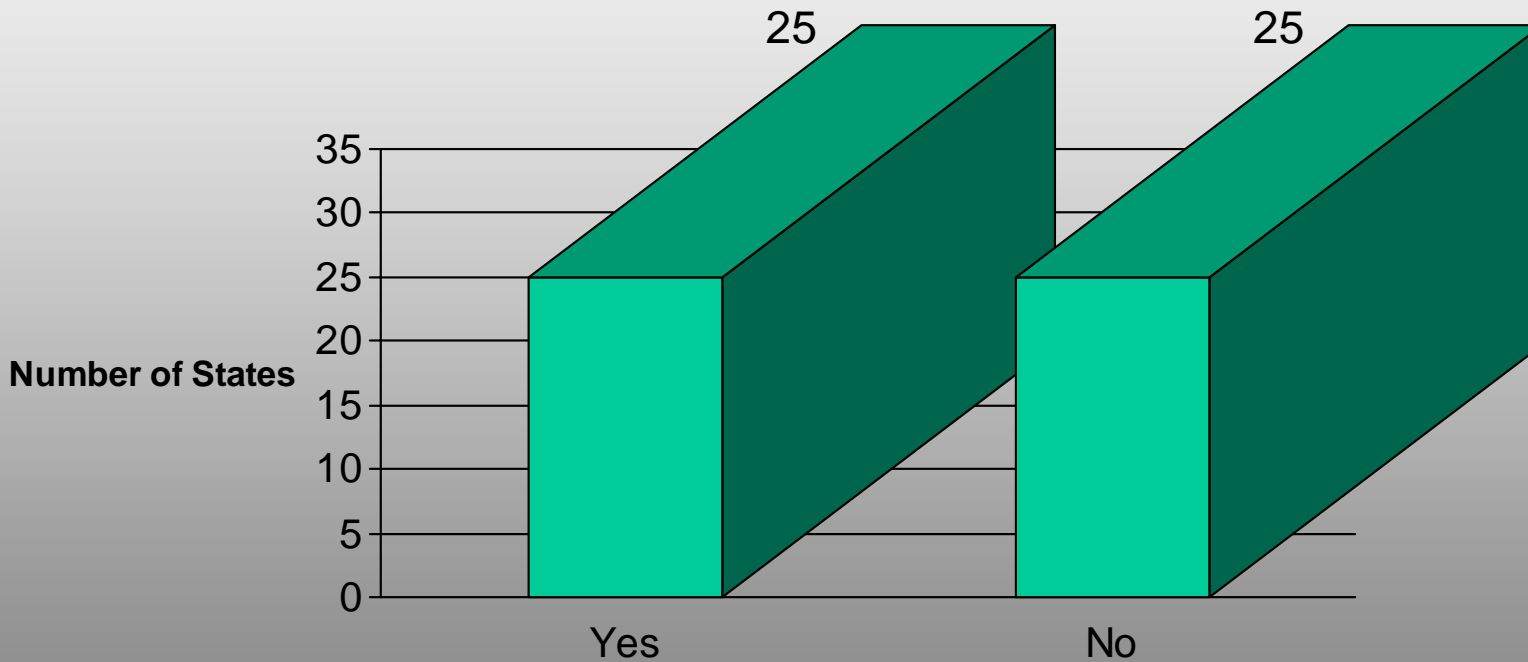

Frequency information in the premises database is updated



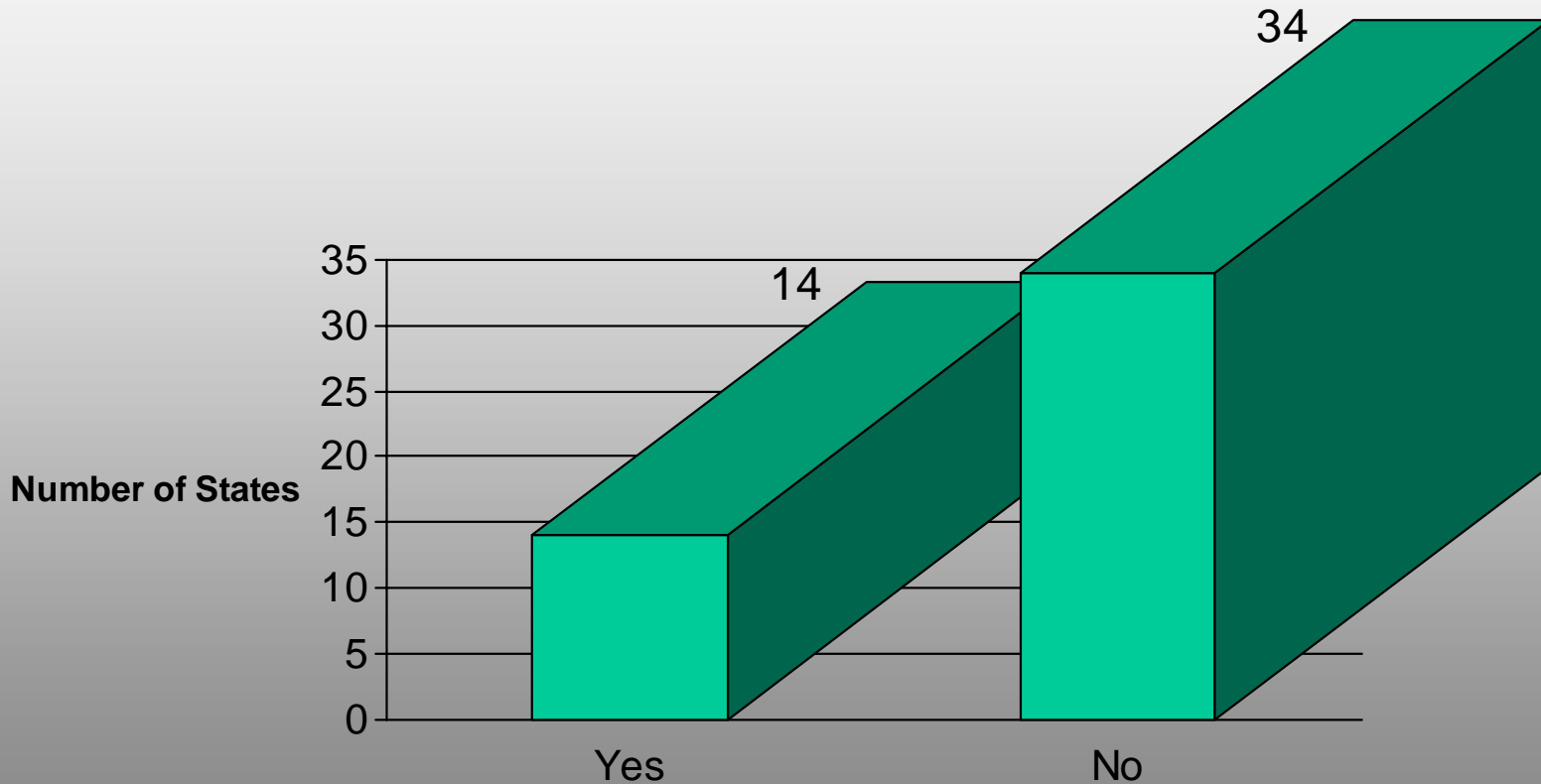

Does your database maintain a record to reflect if the premises is currently active?



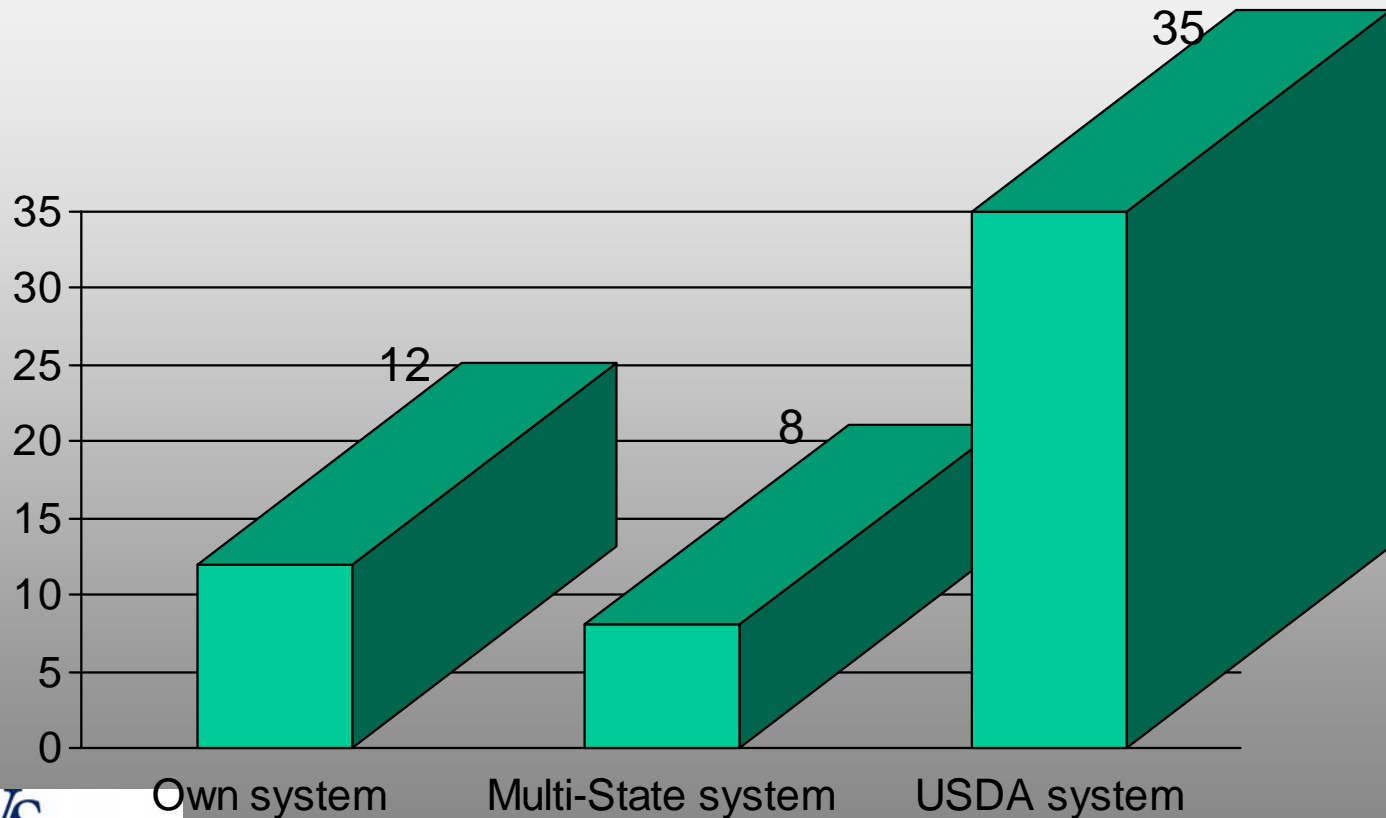

Does your database maintain historic records for each premises?



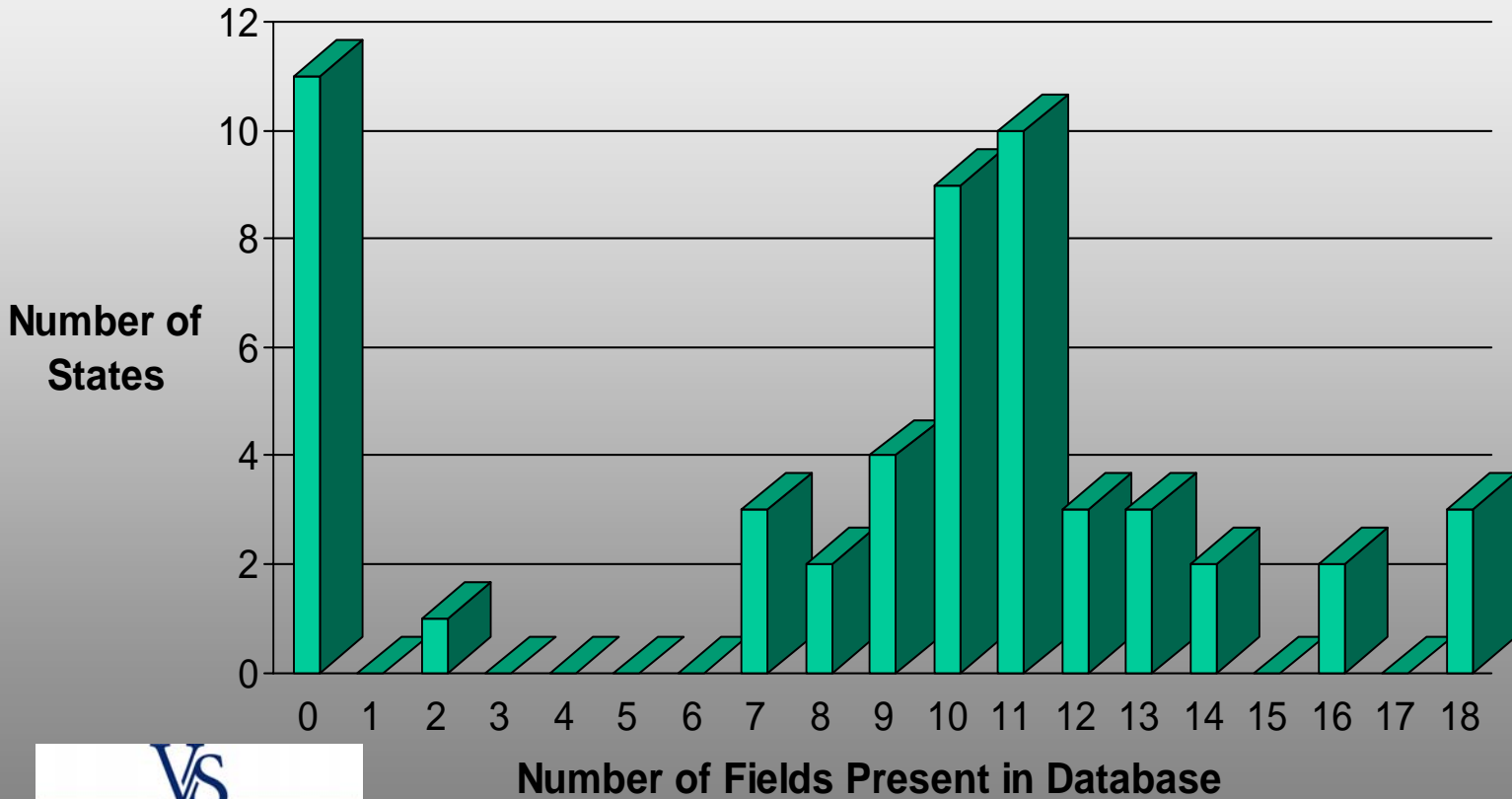

To achieve compliance with the USAIP, which option would your state prefer?



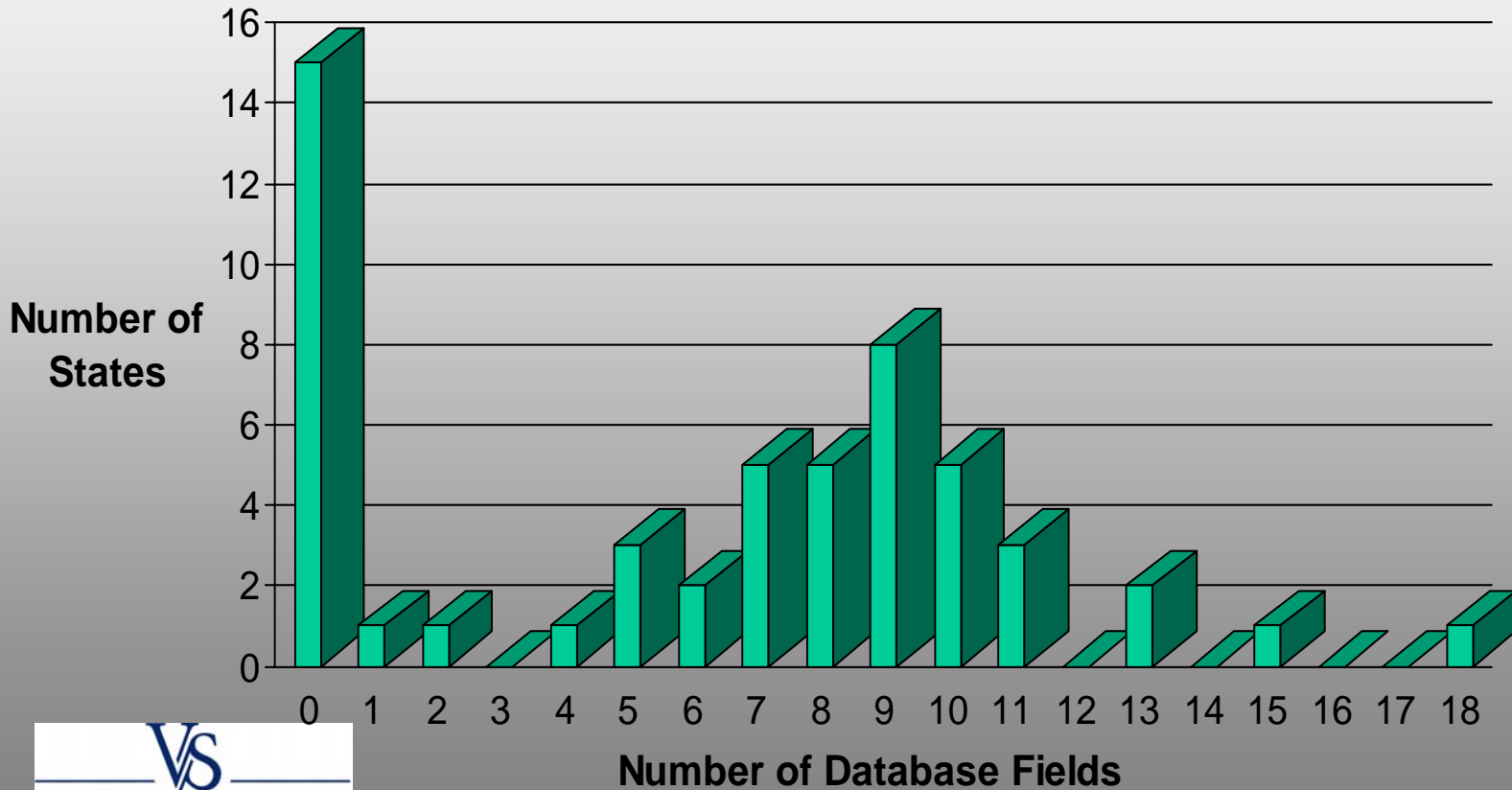

Premises Database Fields Present



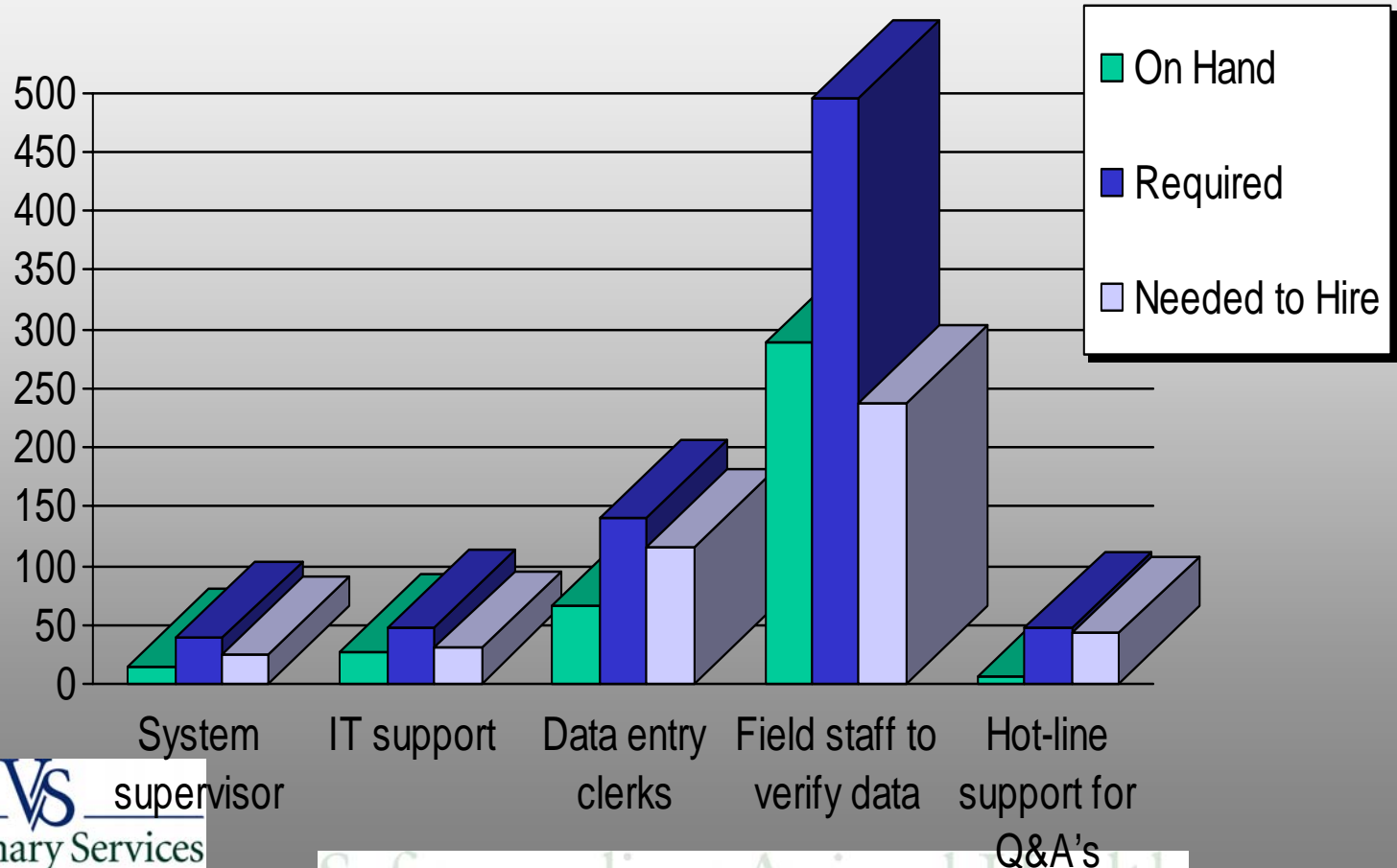

Premises Database Fields Consistent with USAIP



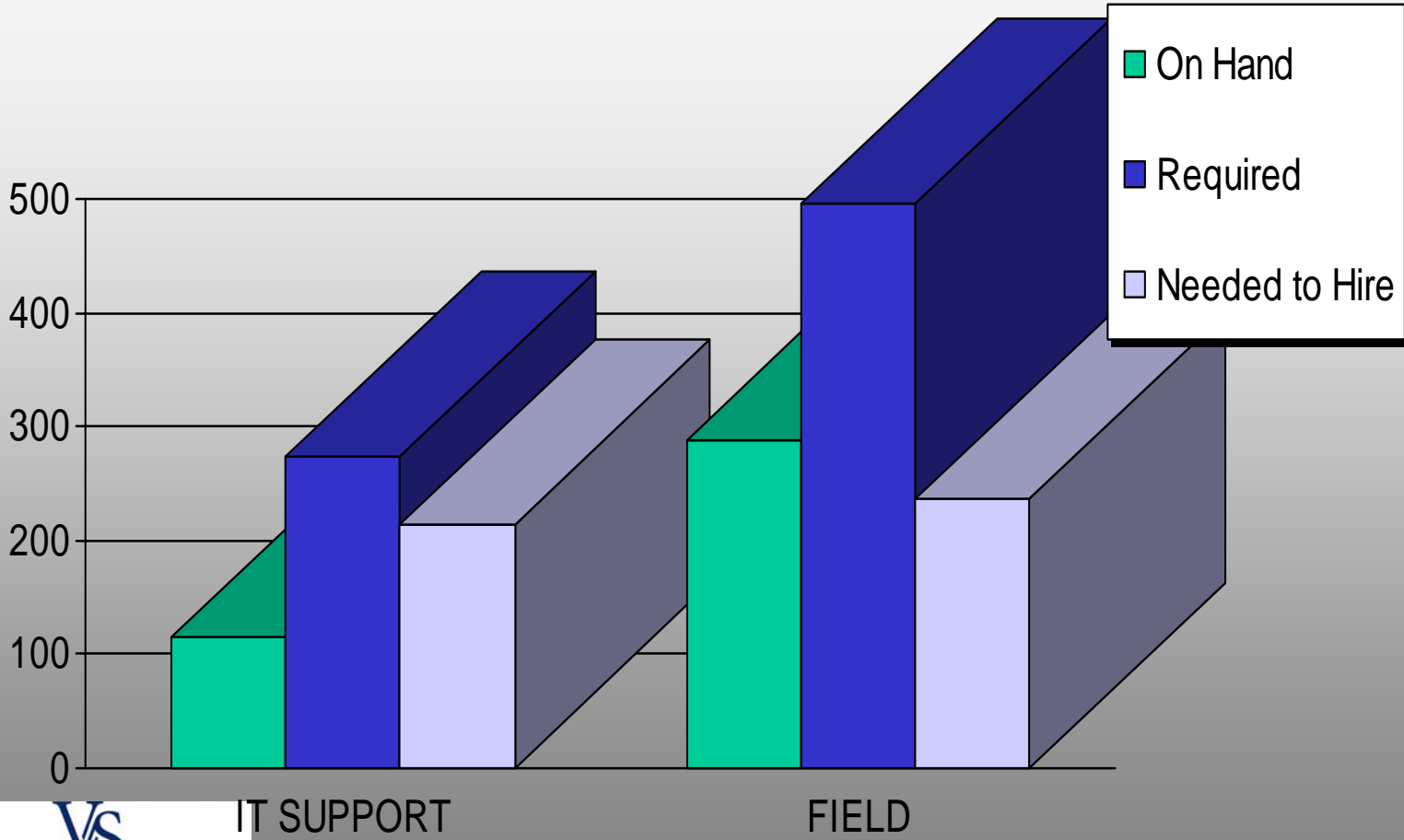

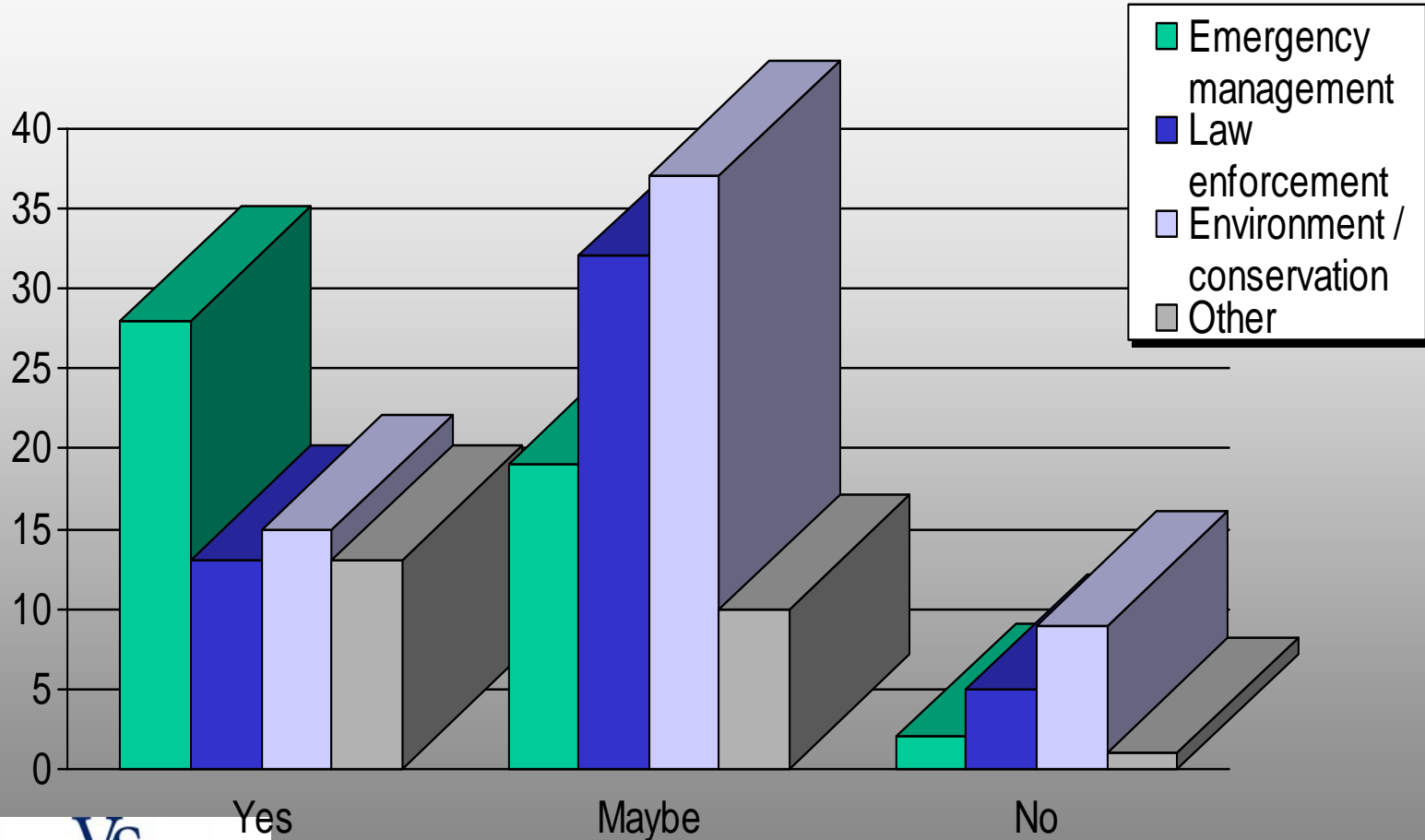

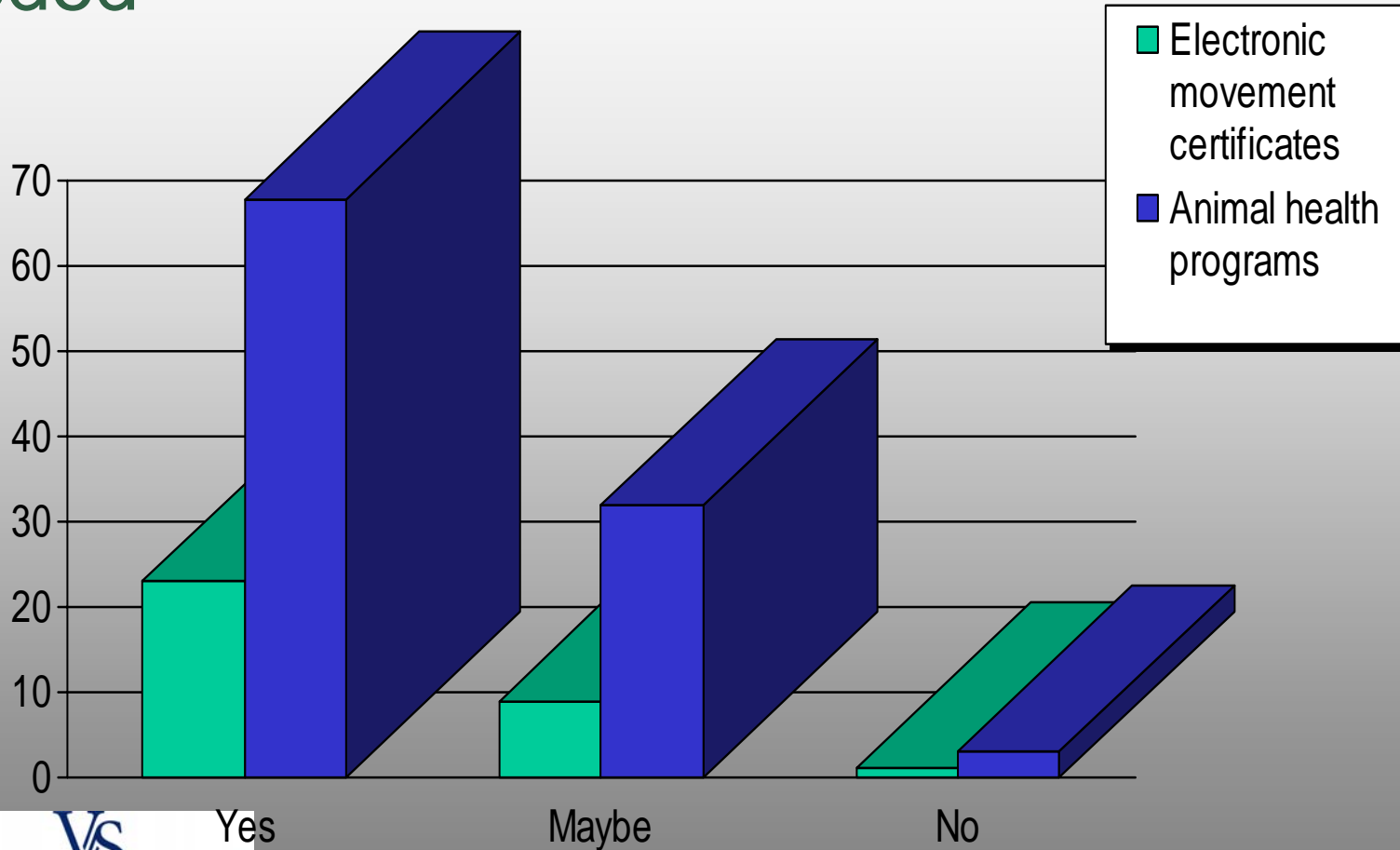

Agency interaction needed



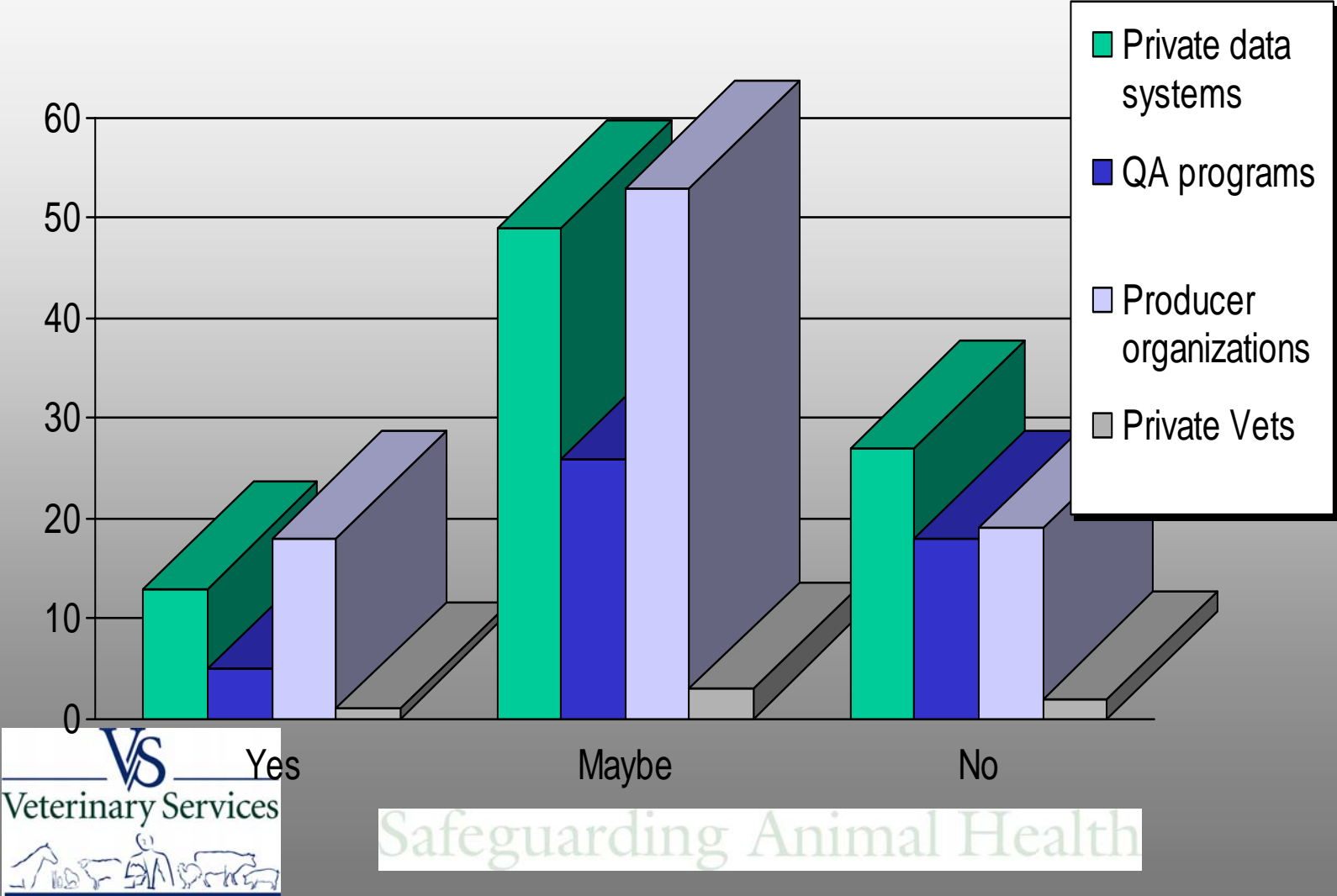
Safeguarding Animal Health

Concerns

- Limited funds
- Limited staff
- Training
- Confidentiality of information
- Large number of small flocks/herds
- Data not current
- Cooperation needed
- Multiple databases at state and federal offices
- Areas without 911 addresses, range land, tribal lands
- Interface with existing databases; data warehouse



Safeguarding Animal Health

Concerns (continued)

- Producer resistance to providing information
- Standardization needed
- Absentee owners
- Need to involve brand inspection agencies
- Prolonged absences of staff
- Need for “user friendly” databases
- Lengthy hiring process at state/federal level
- Multiple premises / Multiple owners
- Slow development at national level
- Conversion of state prem ID's to USAIP prem ID's
