- STARTED IN EARLY 1800s TO CURB CATTLE RUSTLING AND DISEASE
- KNOWN AS NEW MEXICO CATTLE SANITARY BOARD
- A BILL WAS INTRODUCED TO THE TERRITORIAL LEGISLATURE AND BECAME LAW ON MARCH 19, 1887
- COMBINED WITH SHEEP SANITARY BOARD IN 1887

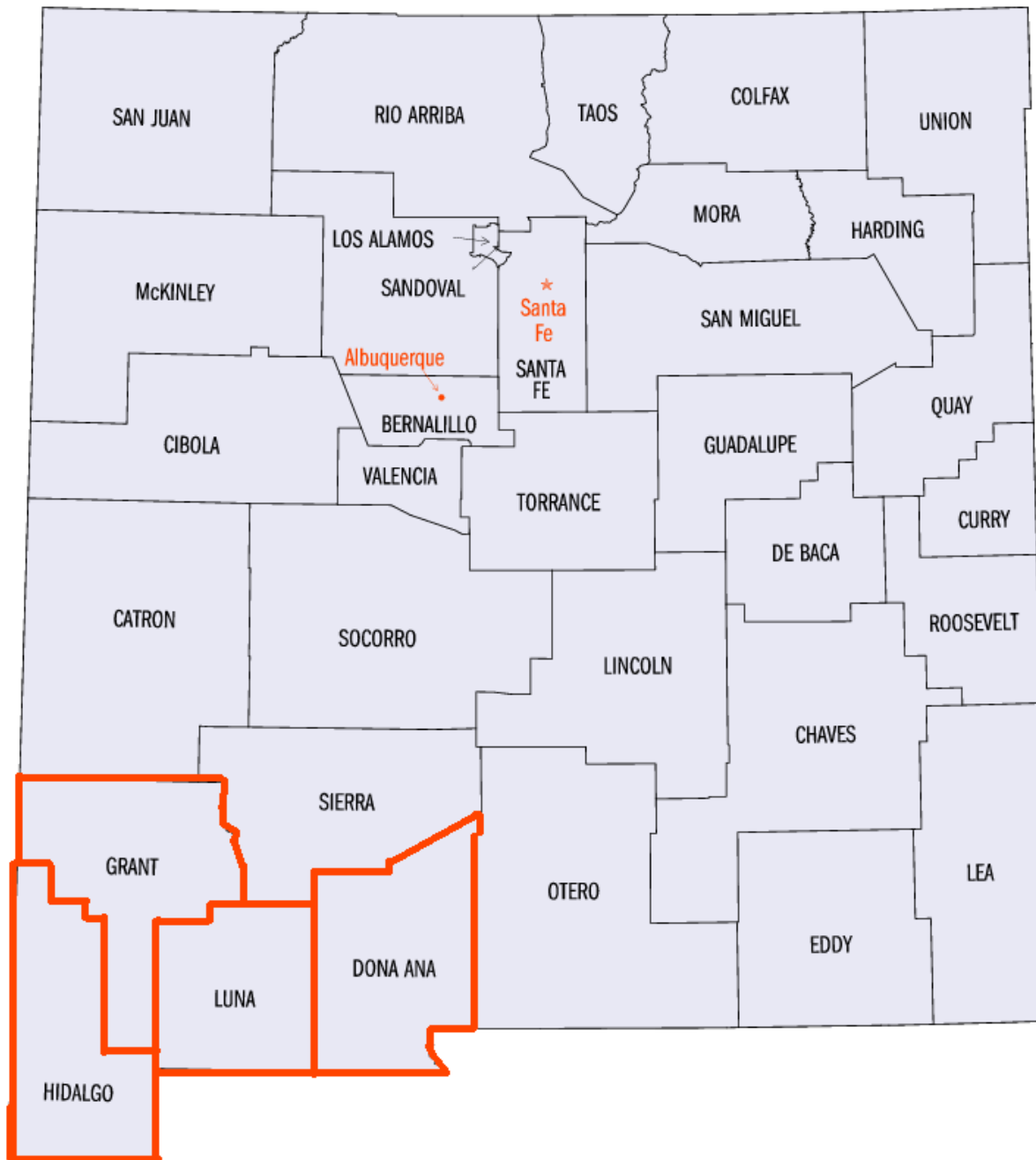
NEW MEXICO LIVESTOCK BOARD
