

NIAA's 12th Annual Antibiotics Symposium

Request for Proposal

Description:

The purpose of the first Symposium in 2011 was for animal health and human health experts to share science-based information so an honest dialogue could ensue. Today, the dialogue is just as important. The 12th Antibiotics Symposium will continue the National Institute for Animal Agriculture's focus on a One Health approach to antimicrobial resistance and stewardship in Alexandria, VA November 1-3, 2022. This year's Symposium, *Exploring Stewardship, Sustainability and Collaboration*, will connect leaders from animal, human and environmental health organizations and provide an opportunity to collaborate on research, education and communication endeavors.

Key Audiences:

- Veterinarians, physicians, and scientists actively involved in antimicrobial stewardship and resistance research, education, and application – on the farm, in the lab, around the boardroom
- Key influencers who reach shoppers, regulators, students, and policy makers
- Key regulatory and policy leaders – state and federal
- Leading farmers, ranchers, and practicing veterinarians
- Human health leaders and organizations – family physicians, dietitians, nurses, etc., ASTHO, CSTE, IDSA, the Pediatric Infectious Disease Society

Selection Process:

All proposals are due August 19, 2022. The Antibiotics Symposium planning committee will review and approve session proposals based on their appeal to the intended audience with the objective of providing a wide range of thought-provoking, informative, and relevant topics for attendees. One proposal will be selected from each presentation topic category (page 2). Decision notifications will be emailed to applicants by August 26, 2022.

Telehealth and stewardship

How has the pandemic and updated regulation affected the future of telehealth in veterinary medicine? Will this be a useful and accessible resource for farmers, ranchers, and veterinarians?

Tracking usage

As federal policy changes, what is being done to communicate the new rules with farmers and ranchers and how is producer usage being tracked?
